Please note: All students are required to wear the Academy uniform. They will not be reminded of our uniform policy and will be issued with a correction if it is not adhered to at all times. Students will be issued with a correction if they do not bring kit to PE lessons, even if they are not taking part due to illness.

Jewellery

No jewellery is allowed, except a wrist watch, one pair of stud earrings and a Medic Alert necklace or bracelet. No jewellery implants or body piercings, including nose and belly button, are allowed.

Nails

False nails and nail polish are not allowed.

Make-up

False eyelashes are not allowed. Any make-up worn by older students should be very discreet. Students will be asked to remove make-up if it is not discreet.

Hairstyles

Hairstyles should be sensible and colours should be natural. No student will be allowed into lessons with unnatural hair colour. Please check with your child's Key Stage Leader before considering any dramatic changes to style or colour. No extreme patterns should be shaved into hairstyles. Hair accessories should be discreet, no scarves or bandanas (except for religious reasons).

Other equipment

Students will require an apron for Design & Technology. The apron should be non-plastic and non-offensive and can be purchased from high street stores, the uniform suppliers, or main reception at school.
