Dear Parent / Carer

I have spoken to your child today regarding their uniform. Our Academy Uniform is outlined in the student planner (pages 6 &7).

The issues addressed include tight fitting (skin tight) trousers or legging type fabric trousers, which are not permitted, or incorrect shoes.

If students are wearing black trousers they are required to be straight legged, slightly flared or boot cut. Denim or skin tight trousers or legging-type fabric are not permitted.

Shoes should be plain black. Boots, canvas type material, suede, trainers, pumps or sandals are not permitted. As the winter months are approaching the uniform which your child is wearing is not appropriate and may hinder their learning due to them being cold and/or damp, if faced with inclement weather travelling to and from school or during the school day.

I have explained that I expect this issue to be resolved as soon as possible and no later than Monday 31st October, after half term. I appreciate your support in the matter. If you have any queries please do not hesitate to contact your child's Form Tutor in the first instance.
