

Year 9 Homework Project Art

Criteria:

- To use correct spellings in everything you write.
- To be artistic and show your skills in one or more area of art.
- To be creative and innovative through using different materials.
- To be able to understand clearly what you have written and communicate this to the teacher on request.
- To show that you have understood the importance of presentation and have sourced good quality materials. (no scrap pieces of paper, no rough edges)

ABORIGINAL ANIMALS:

Task One: **Research** aboriginal art and culture. Create a research body of work, this could be:

A hand created poster

A leaflet

A 3D information sculpture

Or other.

Task Two: **Copy and Analyse** 3 different pieces of aboriginal animal art. You should attempt to copy 3 different designs using different materials to expand your skills. Once this has been done, create a small paragraph answering the following questions:

1. What shapes do your chosen pieces' use?
2. Why did you chose these pieces of their work to copy and not another?
3. What is this piece of work about? What is it trying to get across to the audience? What is its message?
4. How would you improve or change this piece of work?
5. What materials have been used to create these pieces of work?

Task Three: **Take photos** of animals that symbolise you or the place where you come from. Print these off at school or at home and present them academically (mount them onto black sugar paper or other)

Task Four: **Develop** 2 of your own animals in the style of aboriginal art and **describe**, on a separate piece of paper, why you chose those animals and how they are symbolic to you. You must use two different materials minimum to create these designs.

You should also try to develop your skills in different areas of art, think about creating a 3D sculpture of your own design and painting it in the style of aboriginal art.
